Web developers love the graphics that break boxes and columns. Bonus points if you add the text by wrapping images.6. Add a modal window. At least the site half should happen in a modal window.7. Add a Facebook connection button. It's just a button. How much can be implemented? 8. Hide important PSD layers. Later, he tells the developer who lost a hidden element.9. Create rollover buttons, active and clicked states. Then don't tell anyone you did. Create a separate file for them and send it to the last minute. We love surprises.10. Dies the developer of some fantasy functionality that read somewhere on a blog. Then they gave them to build it, because if you saw it somewhere, clearly it is possible.11. Add a carousel. Oh yes, and make sure it's a full screen carousel .12. Use lorem ipsum instead of a real copy. And make sure the reserved space is not large enough for actual copy.13. Change the PSD levels casually. Why isn't it? (But don't merge too many. It will take you further from the magic target of 100 MB) .14. Name All your Final 'files, plus a date and a random letter (final-2010-12-01a.psd, final- 2010-12-01r.psd, final-2010-12-01r.psd, final- 2010-12-02b.psd) .15. Don't worry about making changes once everything is signed. When we ended up with a page, send another completely different version. And tell us that these changes are necessary and essential for the user experience.16. Do not appoint or organize your PSD.17 levels and folders. If you are planning a form, forget the states of error and success. We will wreath those things somewhere. We love to guess your intentions. 18. When you are planning a website, don't invite developers for brainstorming or design meetings. Make sure we are the last to see the layout. Show it first to the customer, so it will be too late to introduce a form of mental in your work.19. We should leave more, so during QA do not use the bug tracking software.
