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Can you cut the wire on a security tag

Many security tags are disabled in the store with an electromagnetic device. To remove them at home, use a high-powered magnet, like a hard disk magnet. Place the magnet on a flat surface and place the tag above with the ink dome or the cartridge facing down. Also the question is, can you cut a security tag? TAG SLIDE-STYLE These tags cannot be removed with a magnet or a Gator tag extractor. These are "Garvey Tags". You can identify the tags in slide style because there will be a small, rectangle hole on the TOP SIDE of them: The reason for the hole is that a piece of metal flows into the hole and pushes on the pin to detach the tag. Gator tags and magnet-remove tags do NOT have a hole on the side of them. To remove these types of tags you must use an appropriate remover tag that looks like this: If you look at the upper left of the image above, you can see that you scroll the security sensor into the tool, then press the trigger on the tool. Shoot a piece of metal often in the tag and the tag is immediately out. IMPORTANT NOTE: You will see tons of lists for these types of online removal. Good quality will cost \$40.125. It is a massive source of frustration and a total waste of money and time. It is better out just throw your \$5 into the trash or purchase a different piece of inventory with it. If you insist on not buying anything to remove a slider-tag (Garvey tag) And if you're willing to risk damaging clothing by making a big hole where the tag is, here's what you can do: 1. Pry out the top of the tag so you can see if there is ink inside. You can use anything you want to separate the first two pieces, to the seam: You can break up with pliers or anything, just be as kind as possible.
