In all cases where there are two objects, and interact with each other, it is defined as exercising force on the other. There are several interactions in play in physics of movement. There are immediate contact interactions, in which interactions between objects have direct contact. There are also remote interactions, in which the interaction takes place without direct contact. You can see this interaction with the magnets or electricity.  , the law of interaction in Nature Nature holds many examples of interaction law. Think of the birds of heaven and how they fly. As the bird pushes down with wings broadcast, there is an opposite reaction to the direction of air force on the bird. These forces are reciprocal interactions. This action and reaction force to couples gives the possibility of flying birds.  ,   , on the ground, you see a tiger in nature. When the tiger runs forward, the legs exercise a movement strength back to the ground. In this case, the terrain exercises its equivalent force and contrary to the tiger, helping to push forward, Fasters.  , the interaction law in everyday life can be seen in the law of interaction in your daily life. When you're on the golf course, it swings the club on the golf ball. However, there is also an opposite force of the ball that affects the club. When action and reaction occur, the ball files forward in the direction in which it was hit. A bike ride is also an example of the interaction law. The feet push the pedals, which exercise a force on the chain to spin the wheels. While the tires roll, interact with the sidewalk, which exercise its strength equal and opposite on the bicycle tires. This is the law of movement, moving the bike ahead. Newton's laws The third law of the movement as defined by Newton follows the first and second laws of how the movement takes place. The first law of Newton's motion is also known as the law of inertia, and his second law of the bike is the law of the quantity of motion. The first law postulates that an object that is in a state of rest or movement will remain in that way unless it was acted by an external force. Imagine a car that starts quickly accelerating at a high rate of speed.
