A doctor and a dentist will be part of the mission team. They are both missionaries in Guatemala. The rest of the team will be nurse and nursing students. The journey was financed entirely through donations and from those who go to the mission journey. Everything that will be used for the journey should be taken with us. This includes all medical supplies, bandages, etc. Donations of medical supplies, bandages, etc. Fund crops are held by those traveling. Every hundredth harvest will be used for benefit directly from the children of Guatemala. Any unused supplies will be left with missionaries.
